The Condition and Development of small cattle-breeding farms in

Uzbekistan

In Uzbekistan, there are:

- 8500 cattle-breeding farms
- 350 joint-stock companies
- 400 shirkat farms (cooperative societies)
- 50 poultry of factories and 40 fishery of joint-stock companies

which have:

- 6,5 million large horned cattle
- 3 million of cows
- 12 million of sheep and goats
- 17 million of agricultural birds



they produce:

- 1 million tons meat
- 4 million tons of milk
- 2 billion pieces of eggs

share of private sector:

in meat - 94%,
in milk - 96 %;
in eggs – 55%.

The Condition and Development of small cattle-breeding farms in Uzbekistan

Share of private sector increases every year. Basically at the farms producers breed:

Strains of cattle

-black-white, brown, red and local amended cattle.

Sheep

-astrakhan, jaidara and hyssar breed.

Local breed of goats

Horses and camels



The Condition and Development of small cattle-breeding farms in Uzbekistan

- Small farms have different numbers of stocks:
 - - 1-3 heads of cattle (62 %)
 - - 3-5 h. (21 %)
 - - 5-10 h. (5 %)
 - - 10-15 h. (6 %)
 - - 15-50 h. (4 %)
 - - 50 and more h. (2 %)
- Advantages of Cattle-breeding are:
 - - steady protein source
 - - work for people living in countryside
 - - contribution in preservation of ancient breeds and species



The Condition and Development of small cattle-breeding farms in Uzbekistan

Problems:

- Inability of using modern methods in stock-breeding industry
- Poor performance in livestock
- Deficiency of stable feed supply
- Deficiency of pedigree works



The Condition and Development of small cattle-breeding farms in Uzbekistan

PRIORITIES:

- Cattle inventarization and identification**
- Governmental support for small farms and cattle producers**
- Firm feedstuff base**
- Pedigree centers formation**
- Preservation of ancient breeds by supporting small farms**
- Implementation of supporting programs for impecunious families (HAFFER and others)**
- Implementation of feedstuffs security projects**
- Improvement in culture of cattle-breeding industry**
