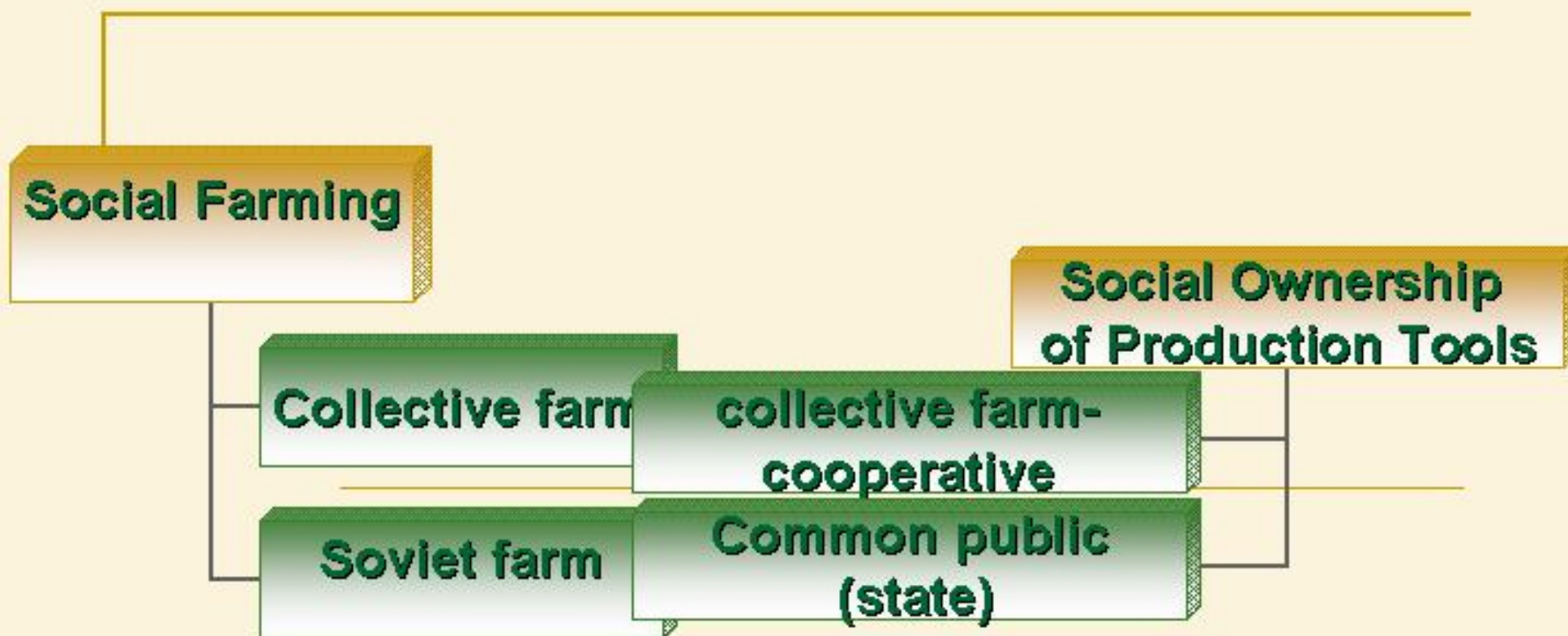

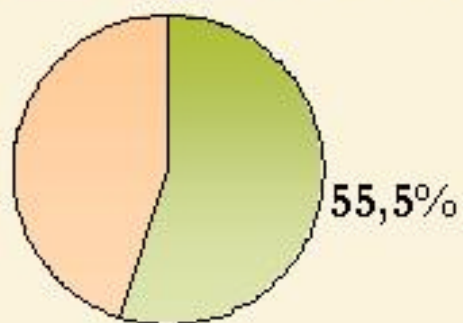
Main Types of Social Farming in Soviet Period



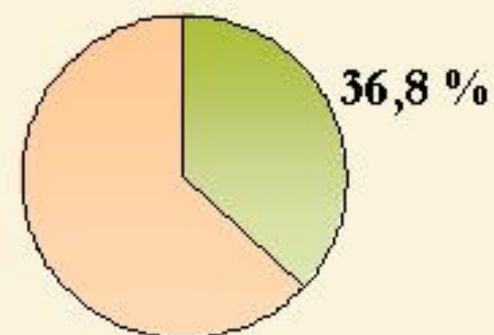
The part of agricultural output was produced in private subsidiary farms

Share of Collective Farms in Georgia

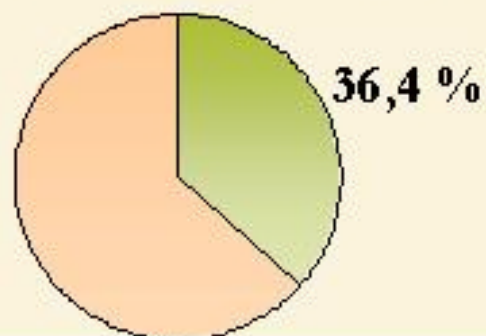
In Agriculture Goods Production
